

# INTERNATIONAL CREATIVE WORKS COMPETITION "EASTER SPIRIT"

## REGULATIONS

### I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Creative Works Competition "Easter Spirit" is organized to foster closer collaboration between the Pagiriai Art School and other art and general education schools in Lithuania and abroad.
2. The Competition is dedicated to the preservation of traditional values.
3. The Competition is organized by Vilnius District Pagiriai Art School.

### II. THEMES, OBJECTIVES, AND TASKS

5. **Themes of creative works:**
  - 5.1. Traditional Easter symbols;
  - 5.2. Contemporary artistic interpretation of Easter;
  - 5.3. Religious and cultural Easter traditions;
  - 5.4. Spring revival and the beauty of nature.
6. **Objective of the Competition:** To showcase students' creative and artistic abilities, promote and publicize students' artistic activities, and encourage children's interest in their nation's culture, history, and Christian traditions.
7. **Tasks of the Competition:**
  - 7.1. To cultivate students' interest in spiritual and moral values and encourage their moral and aesthetic development.
  - 7.3. To develop students' ability to express their views through artistic means.
  - 7.4. To foster creativity, cooperation skills, and self-expression.
  - 7.5. To encourage art teachers to share experiences and collaborate.

### III. COMPETITION ORGANIZATION PROCEDURE

Submission of competition works will take place until **April 10, 2026**, at the following address:

9. The **awards ceremony** for competition winners will take place on **April 16, 2026**, at **Pagiriai Art School (Šiltnameių St. 15-2, Pagiriai, Vilnius District)**.
10. The winning and participating artworks will be exhibited at **Pagiriai Art School and other venues**.

11. The organizers reserve the right to change the exhibition date, time, and location.

#### IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTWORK SUBMISSION

13. The competition accepts **A3 format creative works**.

14. A **completed participant's application form (Annex 1)** must be attached to the back of the artwork.

15. The application form must include:

15.1. Author's name, surname, and age

15.2. Title of the artwork

15.3. Teacher's name, surname, and email address

16. Creative works and the completed application form must be submitted (or sent) by **April 10, 2026**, to the following address:

#### V. COMPETITION EVALUATION AND AWARDS

17. The Competition invites students from Lithuanian and international art and general education schools.

18. Submitted works must be A3 format and created using the following techniques:

**Drawing** (colored pencils, crayons, markers)

**Painting** (gouache, watercolor, acrylic)

**In graphic techniques**

The work must match the competition's theme.

19. Participants are divided into four age groups:

<b>Group I</b>	<b>Group II</b>	<b>Group III</b>	<b>Group IV</b>
6–8 years	9–11 years	12–14 years	15 years and older

20. **Evaluation criteria:**

20.1. Relevance to the theme

20.2. Originality of the artwork

20.3. Artistic quality

20.4. Aesthetic appearance

20.5. Compliance with competition requirements

21. The **competition jury** is appointed by the organizers. The jury's decisions are final and cannot be appealed.

22. All participants and their teachers will receive Certificates of Appreciation.

23. Competition winners and finalists will be awarded diplomas and commemorative gifts and will be invited to the awards ceremony. Detailed information will be sent to teachers via email.

Participants agree to the use of their personal data provided in the application for **publicity purposes.** The School has the right to publish submitted works on its website and social media, including the author's name, surname, teacher's name, and the represented school. The participant's submission serves as consent to these terms.
